

## Spring Signature Collection

### Sample Script



#### 1. Did you sign the health care petition yet?

If people say: “No, I haven’t signed it yet.”

or

“Maybe, I can’t remember.”

Simply say:

***Great! You can sign today. We are collecting signatures to ensure that all residents have access to quality affordable health insurance.***

If people say: “Yes. I signed the petition in the fall.” Simply say:

***I’m sorry, you can only sign this petition once. Thank you.***

#### 2. Are you registered to vote in MA?

#### 3. What town do you live in? (Find or create the appropriate sheet.)

#### 4. Please sign your full name as neatly as possible. (Point where you want them to sign.)

***Write your street address next to it.*** (Point where you want them to write address.) If you can't read their signature easily ask:

***Can you spell your name for me?*** (You print it clearly above, below or next to their name.)

### **Other Possible Scenarios:**

#### 1. If people say: “I thought the Governor signed a health care bill into law?”

Answer with the following:

***Yes. We are collecting signatures to make sure that the new law is not undermined in any way.***

***We are collecting signatures to ensure that the health care law is:***

- ***Implemented fairly***
- ***Affordable to all residents***
- ***Fully funded***

#### 2. If people ask you to tell them more about what this is about simply offer them a blue sheet and say:

***This initiative ensures that all residents of Massachusetts will have access to quality affordable health care. This fact sheet will provide you with more details.***
